International Student Admission Guideline 2025

National Taiwan College of Performing Arts

The Key Points for International Student Admission Application of the College has been approved by the Ministry of Education; Ref. 2014.02.12 Tai Jiou Wun (5) No.1030020474

The quota of independent recruitment of the College has been approved by the Ministry of Education; Ref. 2018.05.17 Tai Jiou Ji (4) No.1080071606J

1. Recruitment standard: This admission guideline complies to the Key Points for International Student Admission Application of the College.
2. Application qualification:
 - (1) An individual of foreign nationality, who has never held nationality status from the Republic of China (“R.O.C.”) and who does not possess an overseas Chinese student status at the time of their application
 - (2) An individual of foreign nationality, pursuant to the following requirements and who has resided overseas (countries or regions other than Mainland China, Hong Kong and Macau) continuously for no less than 6 years is also qualified to apply for admission under this regulation.
 - a. An individual who also is a national of the R.O.C. , but does not hold nor has had a household registration in Taiwan;
 - b. An individual who also was a national of the R.O.C. but has no R.O.C. nationality at the time of their application shall have an annulled status regarding their R.O.C. nationality for no less than 8 years after an annulment of R.O.C. nationality by the Ministry of the Interior;
 - c. Regarding individuals mentioned in the preceding 2 subparagraphs, they must not have studied in Taiwan as an overseas Chinese student nor received placement permission during the same year of the application by the University Entrance Committee for Overseas Chinese Students.
 - (3) According to the Education Cooperation Framework Agreement, a foreign national who was selected by a foreign government, organization, or school, and does not hold a household registration from the time of their birth is not subject to the limitations as prescribed in the preceding 2 paragraphs after receiving the approval from the authorized educational government agencies.
 - (4) An applicant of foreign nationality, concurrently holding a permanent residence status in Hong Kong or Macao, having no history of a household registration record in Taiwan and, at the time of application, has resided in Hong Kong, Macao, or another foreign country for no less than 6 years
 - (5) An applicant being a former citizen of Mainland China and holds a foreign nationality, having no history of household registration record in Taiwan, and at the time of application, has resided overseas continuously for no less than 6 years

The term “reside overseas continuously” prescribed in Subparagraph 2 means a foreign student may stay in Taiwan for no more than a total of 120 days. The term “reside overseas continuously” prescribed in Subparagraphs 4 and 5 means an individual may stay in Taiwan for no more than a total of 120 days per calendar year. However, such a term may be exempted if any of the conditions prescribed below applies and is supported with written proof, and the said domestic length of stay shall be excluded from the overseas length of residency:

- a. Attended overseas youth training courses organized by the Overseas Compatriot Affairs Council or technique training classes accredited by the Ministry of Education;
- b. Attended a Mandarin Chinese language center at a university/college of which foreign student recruitment is approved by the Ministry, and to which the total length of stay is less than 2 years;
- c. Exchange students, whose length of total exchange is less than 2 years; or
- d. An Internship in Taiwan which has been approved by an authorized central government agency, to which the total length of stay is less than 2 years.

The six years calculation period as prescribed in above shall be calculated from the starting date of the semester (Feb. 1st or Aug. 1st) as the designated due date for the time of study.

3. Applicant qualification: Applicant with academic credentials equivalent to high school or vocational school may apply for the College

An international student having completed the applied school program and seeking for continuous education in Taiwan shall follow the same enrollment procedure applicable to domestic students.

5. Application period **March 3 to May 15, 2025**

6. Required papers

- (1) Admission application form (duplicate set)
- (2) Photocopy and two copies of Chinese translation of the graduation certificate of the highest level school (which requires verification by an Overseas Agencies or institutes established or appointed by the Executive Yuan or a private agency commissioned by the Executive Yuan, including domestic foreigners' school)
- (3) Two copies of Chinese translation of the transcript of the complete curriculum (which require stamp seal affixed, sealed, and mailed directly to the College by the issuing school)
- (4) One recommendation letter (including a recommendation letter issued by a teacher of Chinese or a recommendation letter that describes the applicant's proficiency in both Chinese and English)
- (5) Study plan in Chinese
- (6) Autobiography (in Chinese or English) (including Photocopy of track record of talent or previous works-VCD, DVD of personal works or performance and playbill in accordance with each application's situation)
- (7) Language Requirement
Most courses are conducted in Chinese. Applicants should reach at least "A2" level of TOCFL or equivalent levels.
- (8) Financial certificate: USD 15,000 (issued, sealed, and mailed directly to the College by the issuing financial institute) or proof of full scholarship provided by a government, college, or private

(9) Authorization for verification

(10) Affidavit

The foreign school mentioned in Subparagraph 2 of the previous Paragraph, , except overseas Taiwanese schools, shall comply with the applicable Regulations Regarding the Assessment and Recognition of Foreign Academic Credentials for Institutions of Higher Education. The College may request verification on the application documents without verification by Overseas Agencies or institutes established or appointed by the Executive Yuan, or a private agency commissioned by the Executive Yuan as prescribed in Subparagraphs 2 and 9 may request verification. If the said documents have been verified, the College may request examination of the documents.

After admission is granted and at the time of registration, students shall present proof of a medical and injury insurance policy which is valid for at least 6 months from the date the student enters Taiwan. Current student shall present written proof that they have joined Taiwan's the National Health Insurance Plan. The students have not yet procured insurance are required to submit insurance payment to the College, through which the student insurance will be procured.

Insurance procured overseas requires verification by Overseas Agencies.

7. An international student reporting to the College for registration at the time not beyond one-third of the first semester of the current school year shall register for the first semester; or at the time beyond one-third of the first semester of the current school year shall register for the second semester or the next school year.

8. The applicant shall be proficient in Chinese listening, speaking, reading, and writing. Those whose Chinese proficiency proves difficult to keep up with the study in class shall take supplement Chinese language class at their own expenses at the Chinese division at the language centers of domestic universities, international Chinese school, or other Chinese teaching institute. Mandatory Chinese proficiency test may be administered when necessary.

9. An international student who has graduates from a domestic foreigners' school or bi-lingual division (class) of a domestic senior high school may apply for enrollment at the College in accordance with Article 10 of the Key Points for International Student Admission Application of the College by presenting the diploma and full transcripts of the said school.

10. The followings shall be applicable to the tuition payable by an international student:




- (1) Tuition schedule stipulated by the College and applicable to domestic students shall apply to the applicants who are recipients of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs' Taiwan Scholarship and nominees recommended by Overseas Agencies.
- (2) The rules provided by the Education Cooperation Framework Agreement shall apply to the applicants who enroll in accordance with the Agreement.
- (3) The tuition standard applicable to an international student mentioned in the two previous Subparagraphs shall be stipulated by the College, and the tuition standard adopted by the private schools of the level same to the College.

11. Notice of acceptance: Decision on the application will be notified before **July 15, 2025**. Those who are accepted must reply to confirm enrollment before July 29 or will be regarded as forfeiting the acceptance.

12. Notice: The College is a professional skill training school; other than theory and creation, the curricula also include intense physical activities, such as traditional theatric, acrobatic rolling, gymnastic exercise, and physical performance. Professional skill study also includes practice of

professional, theatric exercise (technique) and stage performance; therefore, applicants with visual, audio, speech, motor-skill difficulty, or advised not to participate in intense activities (such as asthma, epilepsy, cardiovascular disease, scoliosis or other major disease) should take discretion before submitting application and consider the affected study in the future.
